Assignment #1 – Can I Get a Color Correction?

Goal:

To use your newfound color correction skills for the purpose of good (looking video).

The Task:

Create a video from the following conversation:

A: Where were you?
B: What do you mean?
A: I mean 'where were you'?
B: You don't know?
A: I'm done playing games. Tell me.
B: I was with you all along. You just didn't know it.

Create three different versions of this short video.

- Version 1 edited, but no color correction. Version 2 – Edited and color correction to make it dark/mysterious.
- Version 3 Edited and color correction to make it happy/light.

You will need to film this scene two times. Get into a group of three or four (depending on class size). Each group member will need to edit their own version for this project (meaning: each group member will edit the footage individually – you film as a group but you edit on your own).

The Final Product:

The final product will be a video that showcases the three videos. The order will be as such:

Version 1 – full screen Version 1 & Version 2 – Split screen (simultaneously) Version 1 & Version 3 - Split screen (simultaneously)

Make each version as close to "cinema style" as possible.

When you are finished, save the final copy to the server in the Assignment 1 folder. Label the project "Assignment 1" with your name after it. Save it as a .264 file.
